Week 3: Putting Fellowship Into Practice

The ingredients of Koinonia stew,

- o Lashings of love - *Love must be sincere* (Romans 12:9-16)
- o Stir in some humility - *[Jesus] did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.* (Philippians 2:6-8)
- o Serve with *paraclesis* (drawing alongside) - *[God] who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God.* (2 Corinthians 1:4)
- o Marinate in attentiveness - *Where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them* (Matthew 18:20)
- o Flavour with forgiveness - *Forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.* (Colossians 3:13)
- o Enrich with encouragement - *Let us consider how we may spur one another on towards love and good deeds* (Hebrews 10:24)
- o And baste with The Word and Prayer - *Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed.* (James 5:16)
